

Parent Involvement

Parents are always welcome to visit the program while it is in session. At any time, a parent may request a conference to meet with program staff to discuss a child's development or adjustment in the program. All such conferences must be arranged through the director. Kid's Castle offers parent-teacher conferences twice per year. They are held in November and May. All attempts are made to schedule them according to the needs of parents.

Parent Communication Board

The parent communication board is located in the front of the building. Topics are changed on a regular basis due to parent requests. Some examples include: healthy meals, television viewing, illness prevention, and other information that can be helpful. These topics are discussed at our Parent Involvement Meetings.

Parent Meetings

Kid's Castle hosts biannual parent meetings to discuss many different topics. At these meetings, parents are encouraged to participate in discussions, express their opinion on specific topics, and help staff to provide the optimum level of care for everyone. Kid's Castle values the opinions of families and strives to accommodate their needs whenever possible. The meetings are an hour long and are held on a weekday evening from 5:00-6:00 p.m. Specific dates are always posted in the parent newsletter, calendars, and on the front door.
